Uniform Expectations

Remember:

- Full school uniform, including your blazer, must be worn at all times.
- Shirts must be worn inside skirts and trousers at all times.
- **Hoodies of any description are not permitted.**
- Trainers are not considered acceptable footwear and should only be worn in PE.
- **Black leather shoes should be worn by all students.**
- It is your responsibility to keep your uniform clean and tidy.
- All items of uniform should be clearly marked (The school is not responsible for articles lost).
- Students/Girls may wear a wristwatch, one ring and one pair of small stud earrings in earlobes only. No other jewellery may be worn; body piercings are strictly forbidden.
- Students/Boys may wear a wrist watch. No other jewellery or adornments may be worn; body piercings are strictly forbidden.
- Hairstyles should be neat and tidy. Hair should be of a natural colour; flamboyantly coloured or bleached hair is not permitted.
- Boys hair should not be longer than collar length.
- Shaved hairstyles (no shorter than a number 2) or stripes/patterns cut into hair are not permitted.
- Make-up, including nail polish, gel polish and fake tan is not permitted.
